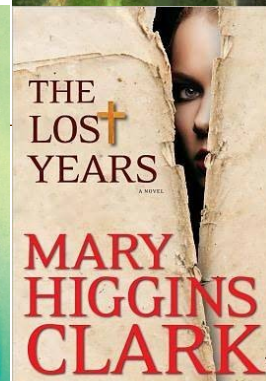
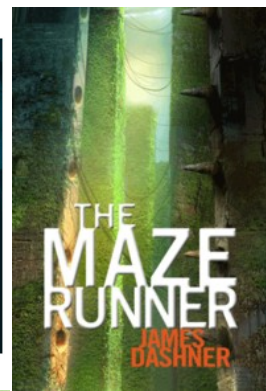
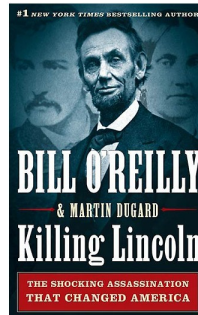


Pillow Workshop Saturday May 5th at 11am. Learn how to make decorative pillows. The Workshop is free and open to ages 12 and older.

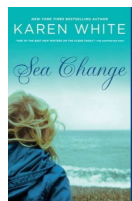
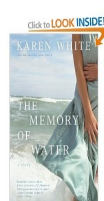
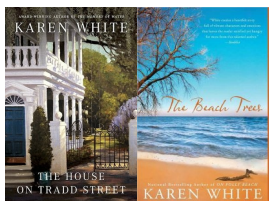


Coming Soon: *Karen White*

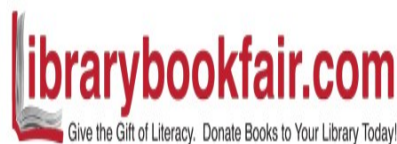


The Lil' Owls Preschool Storytime

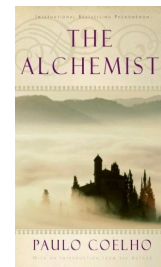
